2. The competition winner(s) will be contacted personally. In the event of there being no reply from the email address, phone number or postal address supplied, Film Street reserves the right to offer the prize(s) to a runner up or withhold it for use in another competition.
3. Film Street will only ever use your personal details for the purposes of administering this competition, and will not pass them on to anyone without your permission. 4. Entries will not be considered if they are deemed in breach of copyright. Trailers must be entirely the work of the entrant and originality will be taken into account by the judges.
